

## VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be REGISTERED in order to receive an absentee ballot. Effective with the Spring **Primary in 2012, proof of identification** must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued. Proof of identification is **not** required for this election.

### TO OBTAIN AN ABSENTEE BALLOT YOU MUST MAKE A REQUEST IN WRITING.

Contact your municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the election. You may also request an absentee ballot by letter. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk. You can also personally go to the municipal clerk's office or other specified location, complete a written application, and vote an absentee ballot during the hours specified for casting an absentee ballot.

The **DEADLINE** for making application to vote absentee **by mail is 5:00 pm. Thursday, August 04, 2011.** The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the municipal clerk's office is **Monday, August 08, 2011.** Deadline for voting an absentee ballot in the municipal clerk's office is **5:00 p.m. on the Friday before the election, August 05, 2011.** All voted ballots must be returned to the municipal clerk so the clerk can deliver them to the proper polling place before the polls close on **Tuesday, August 09, 2011 at 8:00 p.m.** Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
