RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING DEMOLITION COMPETITION**

YEAR - 2013

NOTE: ONLY ONE CARRIER PER DEMO CAR WILL BE ALLOWED INTO THE FENCED PIT AREA. Decisions of the Officials/Judges and Fair Board are final. Extra pit people will be allowed to enter pits at the rate of \$20.00 IN ADDITION TO GATE CHARGES. No young adults less than 16 yrs of age will be allowed in the pit area during demo events. NO EXCEPTIONS!! ALL DEMO CARS ARE TO BE STOCK & WILL BE CHECKED THOROUGHLY BY THE JUDGES BEFORE ENTERING THE PIT AREA. RULES MUST BE FOLLOWED.

- 1) Absolutely NO REINFORCEMENT OR WELDING of any part of the vehicle. NO materials in trunks will be allowed. Fenders & bumpers may be trimmed with a torch. All trunk lids may be secured by the following means: 4 chains or (4) wires or (4) lengths of threaded rod. Threaded $\frac{3}{4}$ " rod max. & must NOT be over 2" exposed above the nut. Maximum hood & trunk plate is 6x6 with maximum $\frac{1}{2}$ " thickness. Two on each side of hood & trunk. (Chains or wires not to exceed 24" in length. Hoods may have up to 6 tie downs.
- 2) All doors on the vehicle must be chained or strapped. Driver's door is the ONLY door that can be welded or supported with a plate no bigger than 4" wide flat stock & extend no more than 3" past front & back door seam.
- 3) ONLY driver's door MUST be painted fluorescent orange. Rest of the doors are to be car color or black. Maximum of three (3) numbers or letters. Numbers/Letters must be 12 inches in height on **BOTH front doors AND on the roof flaps**. NO PROFANITY WILL BE ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON YOUR CAR. SPONSORS ONLY!
- 4) Seatbelts &/or shoulder straps are REQUIRED equipment. The seatbelt must be secured properly to the frame. If your driver seat breaks from frame, you will be required to break your stick.
- 5) Crash helmet, long pants, long sleeved shirt, gloves, and eye protection; such as helmet shield, goggles, or safety glasses are MANDATORY to be worn by contestant.
- 6) Cars are restricted to a maximum of 5 gallons of gas per event. A metal gas line to be positioned through the center of car & through the fire wall. Do NOT run gas line over fire wall. Gas tanks must be securely fastened twice. TAPE is not a fastener. Original gas tanks MUST BE REMOVED prior to arrival at the fairgrounds. NO PLASTIC GAS TANKS! Electric fuel pumps MUST be covered. All electric fuel pumps must have a toggle switch mounted on the left side of the column. Fuel pump & toggle switches must be properly marked/labeled.
- 7) ALL GLASS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE WINDOWS, HEADLIGHTS, TAILLIGHTS, ALONG WITH SEATS & ANY OTHER MISC. JUNK PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT THE FAIRGROUNDS.
- 8) No trailer hitches or pokers are allowed.
- 9) **Mandatory for ALL cars - NO PIPE-NO RUN**. One pipe minimum 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch up to maximum of 6 inch may be used for dash reinforcement and must meet minimum of .095 in thickness. A minimum 2-1/2" pipe (.095"thick) maximum of 6" pipe will be allowed behind driver's seat with a 6x6 inch (minimum $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick) plate on each end with 4-3/8" bolts through doorposts. Pipe cannot exceed 6" from behind driver's seat post.

- 10) All cars must have stock cooling systems at all times. NO ANTIFREEZE ALLOWED - WATER ONLY. Anyone caught with antifreeze on the grounds will be disqualified for the day.
- 11) Minimum 8 inch hole over carburetor in hood. No sharp edges. Mandatory that air cleaner cover be in place.
- 12) The stock batteries (two batteries) must be covered & properly secured & connected. No more than two (2) batteries.
- 13) There will be NO chain tightening devices allowed in the demo.
- 14) Any year bumpers. No welding except on bumper brackets is allowed. No other reinforcement allowed. For additional support drivers will be allowed to chain their bumpers using 1 or 2 chains per bumper. Each chain used may not exceed 36" in length. Chains may be bolted or welded to frame of vehicle. PISTON on BUMPER MUST BE WELDED. Suspension maybe altered but height of front & rear bumpers (bottom of bumper) cannot exceed 25 inches from ground.
- 15) Crush boxes - No stuffing, plating, or welding on frames.
- 16) All cars must have brakes at all times.
- 17) ALL Cars MUST be 1980 or Newer! Only 2 or 4 door sedans or station wagons may be used in competition.
- 18) Tires-Any size but must be-D.O.T. Approved- Valve stem protection allowed.
- 19) A maximum of 25 Bolts are allowed in fender welds, three (3) 3/8 in. bolts are allowed on each hump with 3/8" washers only. No more than 3 per side. One (1) chain or threaded rod is allowed on the rear frame rails. Threaded rod not to exceed 3/4".
- 20) All debris & auto parts must be picked up & put in dumpster before you leave the area.
- 21) Can remove body mounts. 3/4" threaded rod through stock body mount holes. Maximum 3x3 plate or washers.
- 22) Two (2) fires during events - Stick will be broken.

ANY YEAR - COMPACT CARS - PICK-UP TRUCKS - MINI VANS

- 1) Must be 2 wheel drive with a maximum 112 inch wheel base.
- 2) Maximum motor Allowed are 4 cylinder, straight 6, & V-6 engines
- 3) Tires - Maximum 16 inch-D.O.T. Approved-Valve stem protection allowed.
- 4) Above Rules except Rule # 17 also apply to compact cars.
- 5) Front wheel drive cars - Tires may be screwed to rim. Maximum 10 per tire.

CONTESTANTS:

- 1) All contestants must be at least 16 years of age. Entrants 16 to 18 will be accepted with the NOTARIZED approval of parent or guardian.
- 2) Competition fee is \$ 45.00. This includes one (1) car, driver & one (1) pit person. INSPECTIONS WILL BE DONE PRIOR TO ANY REGISTRATION - NO REFUNDS!

3) Any One in pit area judged inebriated (drunk) will be ejected. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES (Bottles or Cans) ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA. ANYONE IN THE PIT AREA CAN BE ASKED AT ANYTIME TO TAKE BREATH ALYZER TEST. Only plastic bottles of soda & water are allowed.

4) Officials have the right to refuse registration to anyone that they feel is not qualified for competition.

5) **PROTEST RULE:** If you feel someone is illegal then give \$ 20.00 fee to judge. Complainant must go with judge to verify. If complainant is correct than they get their \$20.00 back.

THE FAIR ASSOCIATION WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY VEHICLE OR ITS COMPONENTS LEFT ON THE FAIRGROUNDS. ANY VEHICLE ON GROUNDS AFTER 11 a.m. THE DAY AFTER COMPETITION WILL BECOME PROPERTY OF THE FAIR ASSOCIATION.

COMPETITION

1) Any type of collision is legal. Competitors are to avoid striking an opponent in the left (drivers) front door. Deliberate & or repeated violations of hitting drivers door can result in disqualification.

2) Competition will start from a dead stop. Contestants may operate in any direction within the prescribed boundaries.

3) An indicator (stick) will be attached to each car at the start of the competition.

4) **NO DRIVING ON RIMS!** All cars must have 4 tires to continue competition. Excessive sparks will cause disqualification. (Judges call)

5) When a car drives up onto another hood, drivers have 60 sec. to get off or the race will be stopped. If both drivers have unsafe conditions they will be asked to leave their cars. Drivers who were still competing will be put in the next race.

6) When your car dies, DO NOT PUT IN PARK - LEAVE IN NEUTRAL.

7) The last car capable of moving 6 inches & hitting a car will be the winner. In the event 2 or more cars simultaneously demolish each other, the EVENT WILL BE DECLARED A DRAW.

8) Any car that is driven or knocked out of bounds will be disqualified. Out of bounds is considered as any TWO or more wheels that are over the cement surrounding the outside perimeter of the competition area. If your car becomes stuck on the cement bricks you will have 60 sec. to get off or be disqualified.

9) Drivers playing "Possum" will be signaled to get underway. Driver receiving a warning will have an "X" painted on fender. Two warnings will automatically disqualify driver.

10) FINAL CONSOLATION winner will be advanced to the FEATURE.

RULES: Consolation winners of each heat will be pulled out of competition to holding area, there the driver & pit crew will be allowed to work on the car, until the final Consolation race. If the vehicles are not ready when they are called they will be disqualified.

FLAGS:

- 1) GREEN - Starts the race - indicates all clear
- 2) RED - Stops the event
- 3) BLACK - Disqualification
- 4) CHECKERED - End of competition

THE DECISIONS OF THE OFFICIALS, SCORER AND JUDGES ARE ABSOLUTELY FINAL. IF A DRIVER, OR ANYONE ASSOCIATED WITH A DRIVER, INSISTS ON ARGUING, THEY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM ANY FUTURE COMPETITION AND REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS IF NECESSARY. IN THE EVENT A DRIVER FEELS THAT THEY WERE JUDGED UNFAIRLY, THE DRIVER ONLY MAY APPROACH THE JUDGE, BEFORE THE START OF THE NEXT EVENT, AND THE DECISION WILL BE EXPLAINED TO HIM/HER.
