The final estimate of the January 1, 2009 population for ADAMS County is 22,112. This represents a change of 2,192 persons (11.0 percent) since the 2000 census.

Approximately 18,015 of the estimated population for the County of ADAMS are of voting age. The County's voting age population is the summation of the voting age population for all communities within the county. This approximation is a courtesy estimate which helps you comply with Wisconsin Statute 5.66 which requires municipal clerks to approximate the number of electors prior to elections. The voting age population was calculated by applying the census proportion of persons over 18 to the final January 1st estimate, and then multiplying the result by a state-wide factor to account for the general aging of the population.
